* On Campus is defined as any building or property owned or controlled by an institution of higher education within contiguous geographic area of the institution and used by the institution in direct support of, or in a manner related to, the institution's educational purposes, including residence halls; and Property within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution that is owned by the institution but is controlled by another person, is frequently used by students, and supports institutional purposes (Such as a food or other retail vendor).

** In dormitories or other student residences within the "on campus" area.

*** Non-campus buildings or property are described as any building or property owned or controlled by an institution of higher education that is used in direct support of, or in relation to, the institution's educational purposes, is frequently used by students and is not within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution.

**** Public Property is described as "All public property, including thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks, and parking facilities, and is within the campus, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus".

Substance Abuse

Cincinnati State prohibits the unlawful manufacture, possession, use or distributions of drugs on its properties or as part of its activities.

Cincinnati State also prohibits the use or possession of alcoholic beverages on campus property, at any locations where employees or students are conducting College related business or activities, when using College vehicles, except as authorized by campus policy. Students and staff may be accountable to both civil authorities and to the College administration for drug and alcohol related actions, which are a violation of federal, state and local laws, or the College policy. Substance abuse is a serious problem in our society. In response to the problem, Cincinnati State offers the following educational activities and personal assistance to all members of the campus community.

- Information and literature on substance abuse is available in the Counseling Center, Room 168.
- Students, as well as faculty and staff members, who have alcohol or other substance abuse problems, may receive confidential counseling and referral to the appropriate community agencies from the counselors in the Counseling Center, Room 168, or employees may contact the Office of Human Resource Services for assistance.

Sexual Assault Prevention

Cincinnati State College provides literature to help inform the campus community of the seriousness and prevention of sexual assault.

Services We Offer

Motorist Assistance Program - The Department of Public Safety Motorist Assistance Program offers limited assistance with routine vehicular problems, such as dead batteries and keys locked in cars. Due to insurance restrictions, this service can only be offered to individuals parked on Cincinnati State property.

To request Motorist Assistance, please call (513) 569-1558. You may also use the "Info" button on one of the Blue Light Emergency Telephones located throughout campus.

The Motorist Assistance Program is provided free-of-charge and is available 24-hours a day to all Cincinnati State students, faculty and staff.

Locker Assistance - The Department of Public Safety offers locker assistance to faculty, staff and students who have forgotten their combination or lost their keys. Please note that this assistance often requires that the lock be cut off of the locker.

Requests for locker assistance should be made at the Public Safety office, Room 7 of the main building, or by calling extension 1558 [(513) 569-1558 if calling from an outside telephone]. A signed release form is required prior to any lock being cut off of a locker.

Please note that the Department of Public Safety does not assign usage of a locker. Use of a locker is on a first-come, first-served basis. Any open locker is available for use by a faculty or member, or a student.

Campus Escort Service - The Cincinnati State Department of Public Safety Escort Service is designed to enhance safety and peace of mind for anyone who feels unsafe while walking alone on campus.

To request an escort, please call the Public Safety office at (513) 569-1558. You may also press the "Info" button on any of the Blue Light Emergency Telephones located throughout the campus.

The Escort Service is provided free-of-charge and is available 24-hours a day to all Cincinnati State students, faculty and staff.

Lost and Found - The Cincinnati State Lost and Found is located in the Public Safety office, Room 7 of the main building.

The phone number for lost and found is (513) 569-1558.

The Lost and Found is open between 7am and 10pm, Monday through Friday. Property is kept for 30 days and you must provide proof of identification to retrieve lost property. Property not claimed after 30 days is discarded.

Annual Safety Report

Welcome

We are pleased to offer some basic information about our department and its operations.

Cincinnati State Technical and Community College is firmly committed to providing a safe educational and work environment for its community. In order to meet this commitment, the College maintains its own Department of Public Safety. The Campus Department of Public Safety is a service-oriented department. Our police officers serve to further the goals of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, its students, faculty and staff.

The Department of Public Safety is located in Room 7 of the main building and is open from 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 6:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Friday. The Dispatch Center is closed on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. When the Dispatch Center is closed please call 569-1558 or the emergency telephone number 861-8888 for help.

How to Contact the Department of Public Safety.

Another way to contact the Department of Public Safety is by using one of the Emergency Help Phones located around the campus. The phones are yellow with blue lights on top.

The police officers act as representatives of the College to enforce the Conduct Policies as provided by the Ohio Administrative Code and have powers of arrest as provided by the Ohio Revised Code. Officers receive in-service training in First Aid and CPR.

The Department of Public Safety works closely with the Cincinnati Police Division to ensure that crimes are investigated and that victims' concerns are addressed.

Building Security

Campus Department of Public Safety Police Officers lock and secure the facilities in the evening. Police officers report any lighting or operating problems with exterior doors to the Physical Facilities Operations Department.

Emergency Preparedness

Cincinnati State has an emergency preparedness plan that includes response and evacuation procedures for fire, severe weather, earthquake, bomb threat, and hazardous material spills.

Medical Emergencies and First Aid

In the event of injury or illness, the Campus Police Department can provide first aid. All Campus Police Officers receive regular training from the Cincinnati Area Red Cross. For more serious injuries or illness, the Cincinnati Fire Department is summoned to provide emergency care.

Crime Prevention

The Campus Police Department offers educational programs to faculty, staff and students on topics that include personal safety, office security, rape prevention, Operation ID, alcohol awareness and other related topics. To schedule a presentation or obtain information, call 569-1558.

Reporting Crime

All crimes should be reported to the Department of Public Safety as soon as possible by calling the Campus Public Safety Department at 569-1558. If it is an emergency call 861-8888. Each crime will be investigated and given a final disposition.

Students, staff and faculty may report crimes or suspicious activity \anonymously any time by calling the Department of Public Safety at (513) 569-1558. You do not have to give your name and all information will remain confidential.

A safe campus can be achieved only with the cooperation of the entire campus community. Cincinnati State College hopes that you will read and become familiar with the information contained in this document and be responsible for your own safety and the security of others.

The Department of Public Safety gathers and records all criminal activity reported to it by students, staff, faculty and local police authorities. These activities are then published in an annual report on October 1. This report is available on the Internet at <http://www.cinstate.cc.oh.us/Students-Safety.htm> and contains statistics for the past three years. A hard copy of the report is also available at the Student Services Office, Human Resource Office, and the Department of Public Safety Office.

All crimes reported to the Department of Public Safety are recorded in a daily crime log. This information is available during normal business hours and contains information about the nature of the report, date, time, location and disposition.

Timely Warnings

The Public Safety Department will make available information about any crimes or crime trends that have been reported to campus police or to local police that may represent a threat to members of the College community. It is hoped that these timely warnings will aid in the prevention of similar crimes.
