As Cincinnati's premier career college, we offer more than 130 degree and certificate programs as well as a highly interactive learning environment, with small class sizes and seasoned instructors.

Experiential learning through co-op, internships or clinical rotations provides you with an advantage that will make you stand out in the job market and lead to employment offers after graduation. Affordable tuition allows you to save on average 30-50% of tuition compared to most four-year public universities. Whether you plan to complete the first two years of your bachelor's degree at Cincinnati State or go directly into the workforce, you will learn more and go further while spending less. Our financial aid office will assist you with scholarships and completing the FAFSA for grants and loans. On campus work-study positions are also available.

Because we have formal **transfer** agreements with over 20 four-year institutions and credit that is accepted all over the country, you can save on tuition by completing the first two years of your bachelor's degree at Cincinnati State and then transfer. Our transfer partners offer special incentives such as transfer pathways, scholarships, and even admission to their honors program to qualified students. We also have partnerships with Wilmington and Mount St. Joseph University that allow you to earn your bachelor's degree onsite at the Clifton campus.

We know you may be busy working and taking care of family obligations while enrolled in classes. That's why we offer flexible scheduling with day, evening, weekend and online classes and programs. The Clifton campus also offers daycare for students with children.

MyCState Tools

- You will receive an Access Code email containing your MyCState username and student ID number (sent to the email you provided when you applied)
- Create your password for MyCState,
 - Go to <http://www.cincinnati.state.edu> and click on MyCState,
 - Click on Look up username/reset your Cincinnati State password,
 - Click on Reset your password and fill in the form.
- Log into MyCState and setup your SurgeMail email. All future college information will be sent to you via your SurgeMail email account.

Financial Aid

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – go to www.fafsa.gov or [MyStudentAid App](#) – **Cincinnati State School Code is 010345**
- Check your status at MyCState - go to Financial Aid and click on My Financial Aid Documents.
- Complete missing documents if necessary.
- Once your financial aid file is complete, watch for email notification. Your financial aid awards are listed on MyCState – go to Financial Aid and click on My Award.

Advising, Orientation & Registration

- Your letter of Admission will be sent to your mailing address and email with instructions regarding scheduling your advising appointment.
- Complete your New Student Orientation within your MyCState Account.
- Meet with your pathway advisor and register for classes.
- Purchase your books, parking permit and pick up your SurgeCard (student ID) in Student Activities.
