

Transfer Articulation Agreement

Cincinnati State Technical & Community College to the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science Associate of Science Degree

Introduction: This agreement details the applicability of courses from Cincinnati State Associate of Science degree program to the Baccalaureate in Mortuary Science degree program at the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Sciences.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Cincinnati State Technical and Community College who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the Mortuary Science program will enter the third year of the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science baccalaureate Mortuary Science program.

Admission Criteria

Maintaining a grade of C or better in the following courses is preferred:

- CHE 110 Chemistry
- BIO 111 Biology
- BIO 151 Anatomy & Physiology 1
- MAT 151 College Algebra
- COMM 110 Public Speaking
- COMM 105 Interpersonal Communication

Admission Period: Cincinnati State students must be admitted to the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between August 1, 2014 and August 1, 2019.

Agreement Execution Date: August 1, 2014

Agreement End Date: August 1, 2019

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT: This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the administrators of both Colleges and will remain effective for five years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cincinnati State Technical & Community College and the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting this agreement occur. Representatives from both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and /or amendments to this document in writing.
