Admission Period: Cincinnati State students must be admitted to the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science during the duration of this agreement, i.e. between August 1, 2014 and August 1, 2019.

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT: This agreement becomes effective upon its signing by the administrators of both Colleges and will remain effective for five years. At the end of this time, the agreement will be reviewed and may be renegotiated.
