# WHAT IS COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS?

College Credit Plus (CCP) is an opportunity for qualified students (grades 7 - 12) in the state of Ohio to earn both high school credit toward high school graduation and college credit toward a degree at the same time while taking college courses at little or no cost to the student.

## BENEFITS

- Earn college credit and high school credit at the same time
- Take courses not offered or available at your high school
- Engage with college professors
- Access to college resources such as tutoring, facilities and student activities

## RISKS

- **Your grades matter!** Grades earned in college courses impact both your high school and college transcripts and GPAs
- Could be a cost associated with withdrawn or failed courses
- Course selection is key! CCP courses can impact long-term financial aid eligibility
- Academic content can be mature in nature

Students can take classes at any of our four campuses or online. In some cases students can take classes at their high school through our partnerships with their school.

# ELIGIBILITY

## COLLEGE READINESS – SCORES AND BEYOND

To be eligible to participate in the CCP program, students must:

- Comply with the state readiness standards (for additional details, please visit [cincinnatistate.edu/ccp](http://cincinnatistate.edu/ccp))
- Meet course prerequisites
- Adhere to admission requirements



# APPLICATION TIMELINE

For optimal course selection and registration, it is strongly recommended that prospective CCP students submit the online CCP application and required documentation by the timeline outlined below:

**FALL:** Submit all materials by May 1st

**SPRING:** Submit all materials by November 1st

**SUMMER:** Submit all materials by March 1st

**NOTE:** These are recommended timelines, not deadlines. Cincinnati State's CCP program has rolling admission. Private and home-schooled students should refer to the state website ([ohiohighered.org](http://ohiohighered.org)) regarding deadlines specific to state deadlines, which could impact funding. Please check with your high school regarding their deadlines.

# FOCUS ON FIRST

While participating in the CCP program, you can complete your **first semester of college**. You can complete it in a single semester or spread it out over a few years.

### SAMPLE FIRST SEMESTER:

After you complete your first semester, focus on your **first year**.
