Step 1. Apply

Step 2. Request Official Documents

- High School Transcript or GED Test Scores
- College Transcripts (if college courses have been completed)

Optional: Test Scores

Test scores are not required for Admission to the college; however, they can be useful for advising purposes. Therefore, we encourage students who have taken the ACT or SAT within the past two years to request that their scores be included on their high school transcript or sent from the testing service. Our school code for the ACT is 5570 and SAT is 1984.

MyCState Tools

- You will receive an Access Code email containing your MyCState username and student ID number (sent to the email you provided when you applied)
- Create your password for MyCState:

 - Click on "Look up username/reset your password,"
 - Click on "Reset password" and fill in the form.
- Log into MyCState and set up your SurgeMail email. All future college communications will be sent to you via your SurgeMail account.

Financial Aid

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – go to www.fafsa.gov or [MyStudentAid App](#) – **Cincinnati State School Code is 010345**
- Check your status at MyCState - go to Financial Aid and click on "My Financial Aid Documents."
- Complete missing documents if necessary.
- Once your financial aid file is complete, watch for email notification. Your financial aid awards are listed on MyCState – go to Financial Aid and click on My Award.

- Complete your New Student Orientation online within your MyCState account.
- Meet with your pathway advisor and register for classes.
