Tuition = \$7,164.96

Lab Fees and Supplemental Fees = \$1,875

(Supplemental fees cover ATI testing and remediation program)

Advanced Technology Fees (\$37.50/sem X 3 sem) = \$112.50

CPR Certification, AHA Type C = \$183.64

Estimate of Textbooks and Materials = \$1000

Estimated Physical and Required Immunizations Costs = \$500

FBI and BCII Background Checks = \$62

Estimated Uniform, Lab Coat, Watch and Stethoscope Costs = \$200

Total Estimated Costs = \$11,660.60

Non-Resident Students: tuition is \$367.28/credit hour

Additional tuition = \$7,164.96 Total Estimate Costs for Non-Resident Student = \$18,825.56
