Our transfer partners offer special incentives such as transfer pathways, scholarships, and even admission to their honors program to qualified students. We also have partnerships with Wilmington, Miami Regionals, and Mount St. Joseph University that allow you to earn your bachelor's degree onsite at the Clifton campus.

We know you may be busy working and taking care of family obligations while enrolled in classes. That's why we offer flexible scheduling with day, evening, weekend and online classes and programs. The Clifton campus also offers daycare for students with children.
