- ☐ High school diploma/certification and transcript
 - Provide copy in original language as well as English translation. See translation providers below.
 - If you attended a U.S. high school - the transcript must come directly from the high school and may be faxed to 513-569-1562, emailed to adm@cincinnati-state.edu, or mailed to:

- ☐ College transcript (if attended)
 - If transferring coursework/credits provide transcript(s) in original language as well as English translation and a course-by-course evaluation from a member of NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services <https://www.naces.org/members>).  - If you attended a U.S. College/University - the transcript must come directly from the institution. If you have an associate's degree or higher the high school documents are not necessary.

Step 3. Provide Proof of English Proficiency

- ☐ Provide one of the following to demonstrate English proficiency:
 - **TOEFL - Test of English as a Foreign Language**
Request TOEFL scores to be sent to Cincinnati State. Must be less than two years old, with a minimum score of 500 (Paper), 173 (Computer) or 61 (Internet-based). The Educational Testing Service school code for Cincinnati State is 1984.
 - **IELTS - International English Language Testing System**
Request IELTS scores to be sent to Cincinnati State. Must be less than two years old, with a minimum score of 5.
 - **College Level English**
Request official transcripts verifying successful completion of any college level English course with a grade of C or higher from a regionally accredited U.S. college or university.
 - **U.S. High School**
Request official high school transcript verifying a minimum of 2.0 cumulative GPA.
 - **English Speaking Country**
Proof of completion of secondary school in an English-speaking country. See list of qualifying countries at www.cincinnati-state.edu/international.

Step 4. College Admission and Obtain Your I-20

- ☐ Admission
Please allow 14 business days for Cincinnati State to process your documents and send you a letter of admission to the College. Your letter will be emailed, as well as mailed to your home address.
- ☐ International Student Enrollment Form (ISEF) & I-20
Once you receive your letter of admission to the college, complete and submit the ISEF and required documents. An I-20 Form is issued only after the ISEF and all required documents are received and processed prior to the start of the semester. Visit www.cincinnati-state.edu/international-students for details.
- ☐ Obtain your Visa
Follow the steps in your home country to obtain your Visa.
