About Post 9/11

- The Post 9/11 education benefits are granted on a percentage scale depending on military service.
 - Tuition—paid to school
 - Housing—paid to student monthly
 - Also covers most textbooks

Minimum Eligibility Requirement

90 aggregate days of service of active duty after 9/10/11

Individuals serving an aggregate period of active duty	% of Maximum Benefit
after Sept 11, 2001 of:	Payable
At least 36 months	100%
At least 30 continuous days and discharged due to service- connected disability	100%
At least 30 months < 36 months	90%
At least 24 months < 30 months	80%
At least 18 months < 24 months	70%
At least 12 months < 18 months	60%
At least 6 months <12 months	50%
At least 90 days < 6 months	40%

Next Steps

- After you obtain your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from your e-benefits account, you must submit it to <u>Veterans@CincinnatiState.edu</u>
 - You may be asked to submit a Statement of Benefits, which states how much time you have remaining on your benefits
- Every semester that you wish to use your benefits, you must submit your statement of benefits and your semester schedule to <u>Veterans@CincinnatiState.edu</u>
