The Cincinnati State Technical and Community College Presidential finalists are (in alphabetical order):

David Ferreira, Ed.D., is the Provost of Charter Oak State College, CT. Previously, Dr. Ferreira served as the Dean of Academic & Student Affairs of Northwestern Connecticut Community College, CT. Dr. Ferreira earned a Doctor of Education in Higher Education Leadership from Northcentral University; a Master of Arts in Political Science from American University; and a Bachelor of Science in Political Science from Southern Connecticut State University.

Robbin Hoopes, M.A., J.D., is the Provost of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, OH. Previously, Mr. Hoopes served as the Dean of Humanities and Sciences of Cincinnati State Technical and Community College, OH. Mr. Hoopes earned a Juris Doctorate from the University of Cincinnati College of Law; a Master of Arts in Linguistics from Gallaudet University; and a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from the University of Akron.

Marc Singer, Ed.D., is the Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs of Northampton Community College, PA. Previously, Dr. Singer served as the Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs of SUNY Sullivan, NY. Dr. Singer earned a Doctor of Education in Distance Learning from Athabasca University; a Master of Philosophy in American Studies from New York University; a Master of Arts in American Studies from the University of Alabama; and a Bachelor of Arts in English/American Civilization from Oberlin College.

Open Forums will take place on July 14, 15, and 16, with two 1-hour forums each day, in the Advanced Technology and Learning Center (ATLC) Auditorium (ATLC 211), from 11

a.m. to noon and also from 1:15 to 2:15 p.m. Both times are open to anyone who wishes to attend.
